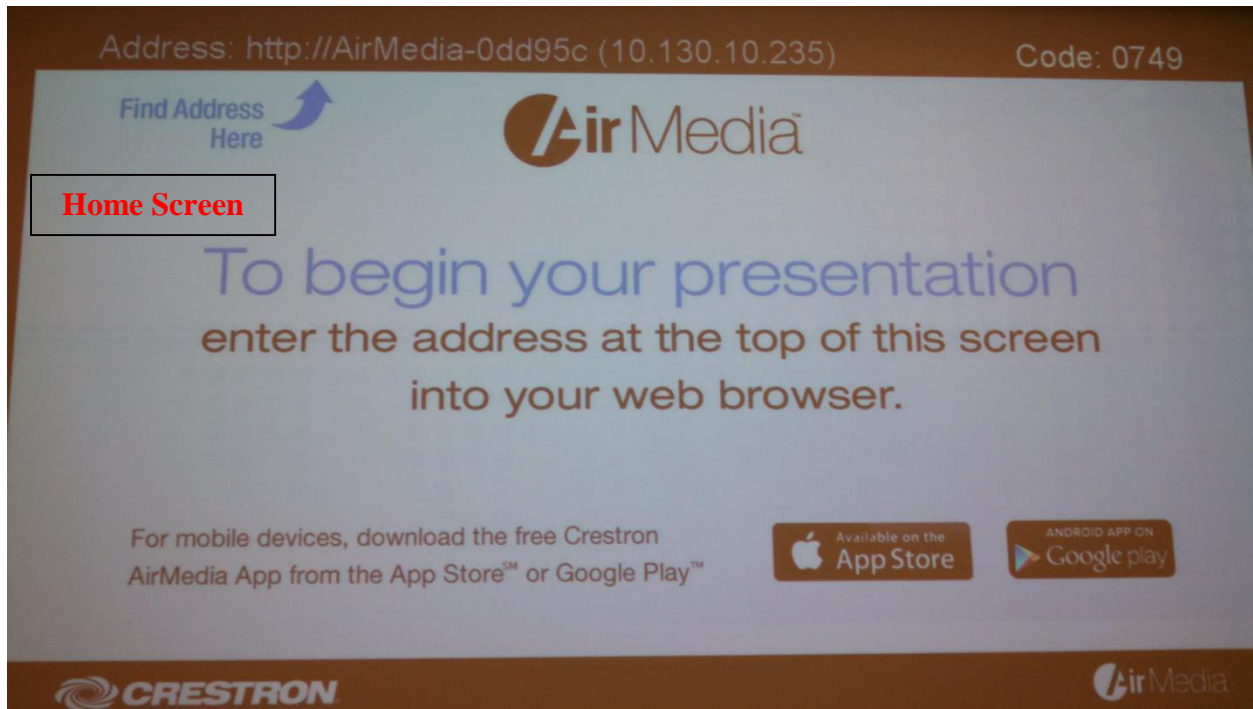


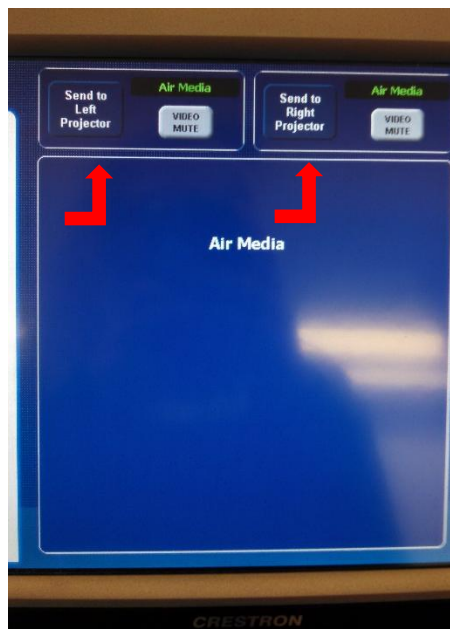
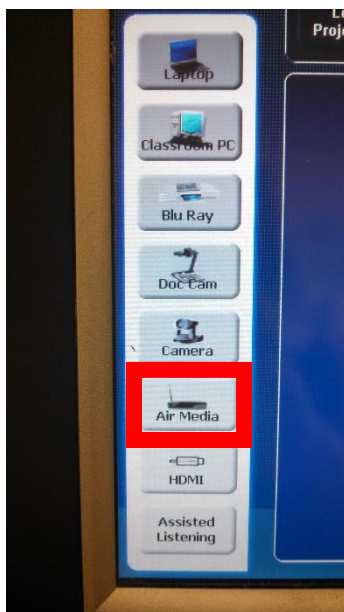
What Air Media Does

Allows students to wirelessly connect to projectors to make presentations easier than ever before!



How to Use Air Media

From the Crestron, send Air Media to both projectors

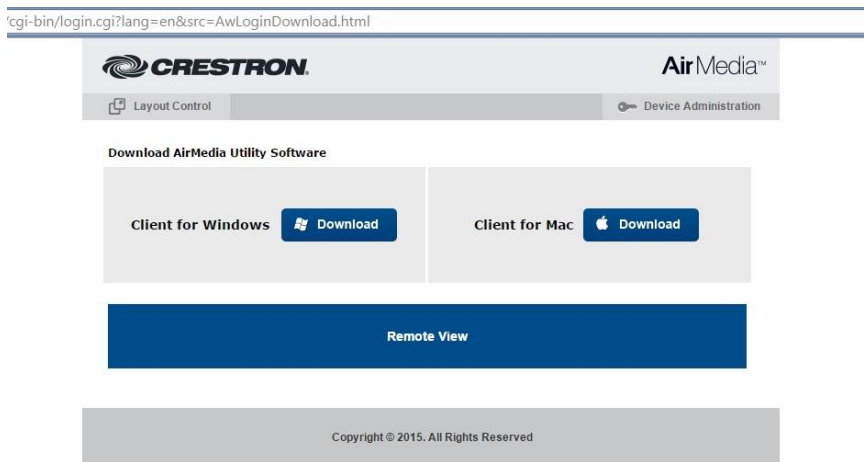


Look at the top line to find the IP address to type in

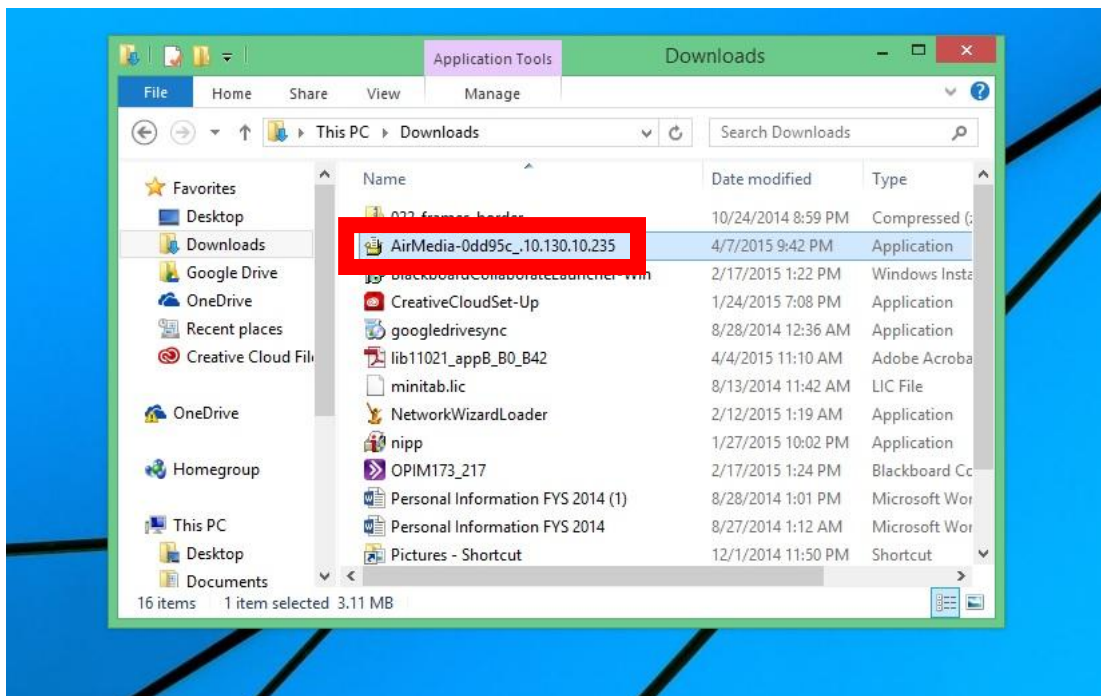
On your laptop, type the IP address into your search bar



Download Client for the appropriate computer type

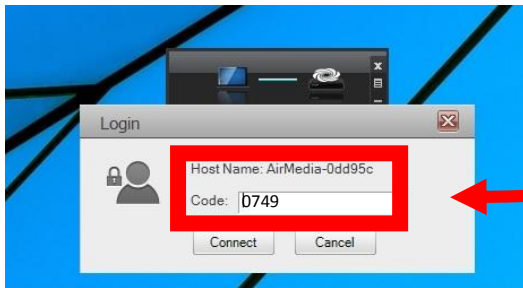


Open the download file (should be called AirMedia-0dd95c_.10.130.10.###)



After the computer finds the AirMedia device, it will ask for the security code

Type in the security code found at the top right of the screen



Click Connect and voila! You can now project without having to leave your seat!

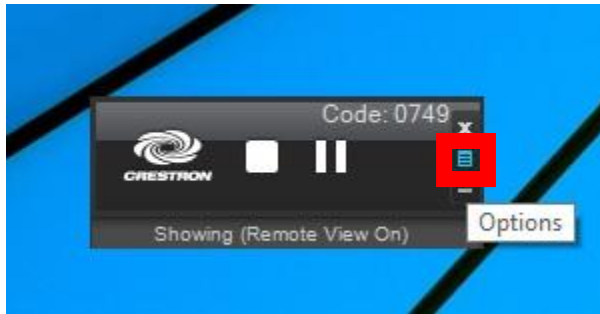
Remote View Function

How to Use Room View Function

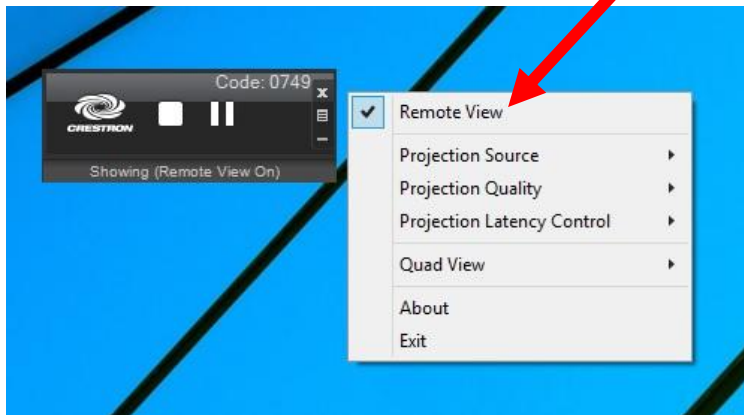
This feature allows you to share your screen with those watching your presentation

The person presenting: Click on options



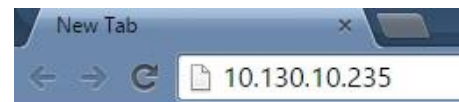
Click on the “Remote View” to enable it



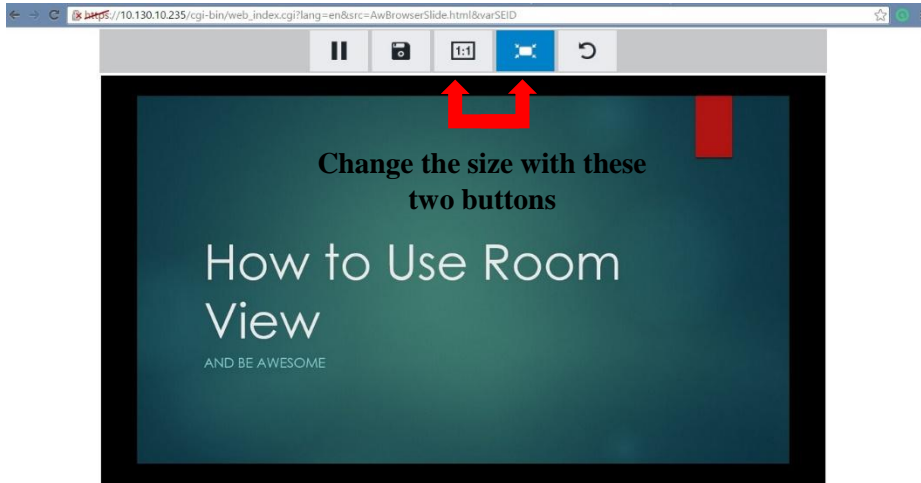
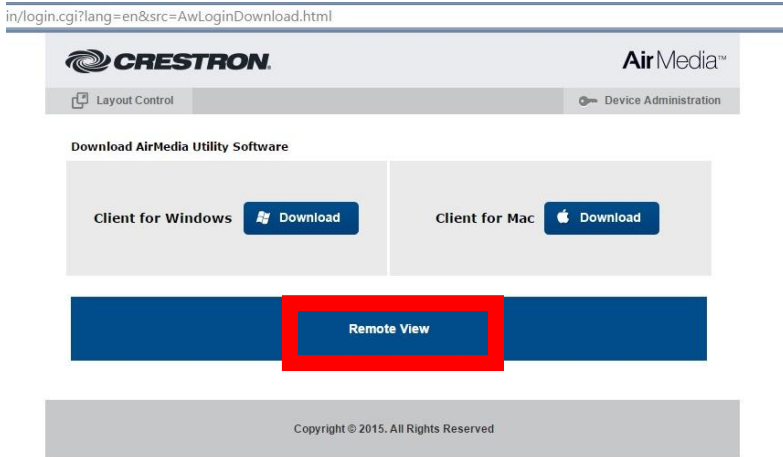
To Use

Those who are watching the presentation: Type the IP address into your internet browser

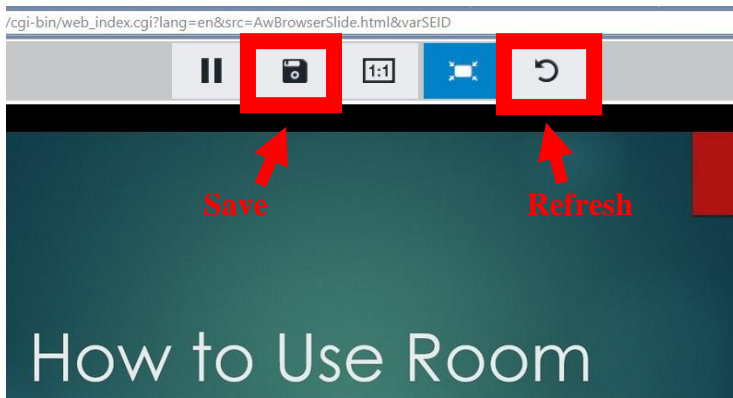
